

Matt Kizer has an online 10 minute animated video - The Lighting Design Process https://scenicandlighting.com/article/the-lighting-design-process/ that covers all aspects of how lighting design affects the theatre performance. Matt explains and demonstrates the McCandless Method of lighting design. This video is useful for all on stage and off-stage persons as it is helpful to see what theatre lighting can do for your production.

An introduction To Theatre Lighting Workshop runs for 3 hours, with breaks and can be followed up with Advanced Lighting Design and Programming which runs for several hours, depending on what the participants want to learn.



I know many of you will be happy to hear that we are discussing going back to the good old days when we would hold Club Nights during the months when the theatre is dark.


